Our goal is to provide love, support and guidance of a family that they have lost—setting them up not just to survive in the world, but to thrive.

The Casa Hogar Community goes beyond just the four walls and years spent at our home. We continue to support our graduates both emotionally and financially once they leave Casa Hogar through the Project of Life Program. Working with our staff, they begin to explore different life paths and make sound plans for their future, helping many graduates to continue their education and find successful careers.

As the central hub for an association of 19 orphanages
