Today, we are calling you to **continue your investment** in Casa Hogar so that we may continue to provide the children, families and communities with a safe, thriving and loving environment which they can call home.

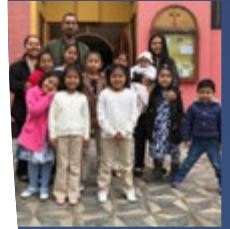
We ask you to prayerfully consider a gift to Casa Hogar during this Christmas Season.

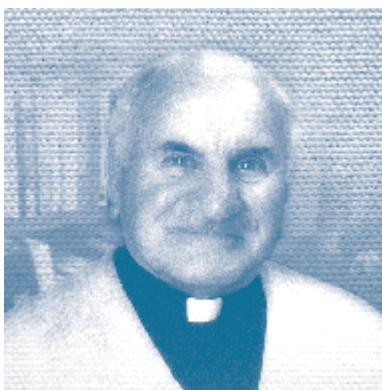
